TSAA Tournament Bid Application

With submission of this bid package the host understands that TSAA will receive 20% of the entry fee for each participant in the tournament. In exchange for their 20% fee, TSAA will handle registration online, judge reimbursement, sanctioning the event and web page publicity. TSAA will recommend an appropriate number of judges and reimburse the judges' stipend for working the event. The host will reimburse any "extra" judges that are asked to officiate. TSAA will also pay to register the event with USA Archery for Sanctioning and also as a Star FITA if appropriate. The host will cover all other expenses, including target faces, score cards, water for the archers, concessions, and awards.

The host/ tournament director also agrees to compile the tournament results and submit them in a spreadsheet format (provided by the TSAA) via email to the webmaster for posting within 48 hours of the tournament completion. An after-tournament report including the number of participants and any state records tied or broken should also accompany the score submission. A brief write-up of the event is requested, but not required. Any suitable photos, particularly group photos, are also desired for posting on the website. Awards should be presented at the close of the event; if archer is not present then the organizer should facilitate how archers will receive their awards, such as, through friends present or making available at future events. Archers may choose to pay postage/costs for mailing of award. The TSAA will make available target faces for purchase at the Maple Leaf "100" count price. Score cards must adhere to WA standards (to support record claims), and examples are available on the Documents page of the website.
