	Distance4	<i>30,30,80</i>	*** AR1 optionally uses special compound equipment with mechanical release that is considered to be in the AR1 division

	NAA <i>Senior</i> division is equivalent to FITA <i>Senior</i> division.					
	NAA <i>Master</i> division (aka Master 50+) is equivalent to FITA <i>Master</i> division.					
	NAA <i>Junior</i> division is equivalent to FITA <i>Junior</i> division.					
	FITA also recognizes 25 meters distance indoors, and even a combination 18/25 round, but they are rarely used in the US.					
	Archers who qualify for a particular division automatically are eligible for more competitive divisions if they choose to use them.					
	For example, cadets are eligible to compete as Junior or Senior, Master 70+ are eligible to compete as Master or Senior as well.
