

RULES: FITA rules apply.

For CAP entrants:

- Individual entrants must be USA Archery & College Archery Program Eligible Status members.
- Coaches must be USA Archery members and designated by the school(s) represented.
- Schools represented must be USA Archery club members and CAP recognized.
- Optional "FUN" Team OR Round. Unless otherwise designated, teams will be mixed gender, mixed bow types, and mixed schools. You may designate a team if it is Gender and Bow Type consistent (ie a group that is essentially practicing together to be a team at USIACs). This is always a highlight of the event !
- At 30m, all archers will shoot the 80cm 6-ring multi-face setup unless designated otherwise on the registration form.

For GUEST entrants:

- Individual entrants must be USA Archery and/or NFAA members.
- Only Senior divisions (90, 70, 50, 30 meters and 70, 60, 50, 30 meters) will be offered for FITA round purposes. NO SR+ or JOAD specific distances/categories.
- At 30m, all archers will shoot the 80cm 6-ring multi-face setup.
- *GUESTs may alternatively register to shoot a 900 round* (60, 50, 40 meters at the 122cm face). This is ideal for newer CAP archers (aka JVs) who may not be able to get the distances yet, or JOAD or SR+ archers.
- Awards for GUESTs WILL NOT be given, but folks will be recognized.
- As the CAP West Regional Champions are decided by the ORs, GUESTs who shoot the FITA portion will compete in separate OR brackets. GUESTs who shoot in the 900 round will NOT be eligible to participate in the ORs as there is no way to accurately rank them and maintain our STAR FITA status.
- All GUESTs will be allowed to compete separately (not against the CAP teams) in an "Optional Fun Team OR" if enough people are interested.

- If an archer used to go bow hunting with friends or family... he/she does not qualify.
- If an archer used to shoot compound, but switched to recurve for this year (or visa versa)... he/she does not qualify.
- If an archer took a class for archery prior to August 1, 2007... he/she does not qualify.

The point of this "category" is to truly honor the rookies who are just learning to shoot and are out there showing a commitment to excellence in the sport. So, PLEASE... no truth fudging.
