Hosted by: North Dallas JOAD

WHEN: January 22-24, 2016

WHAT: Adult Lines: A double FITA I (60 arrows at 18 meters on a 40 centimeter face) at two separate times for adults and youths shooting the adult round.

JOAD Line: All archers will shoot a single FITA I (60 arrows at 18 meters), except Yeoman (30 arrows at 9 meters on a 60cm target face). All compound archers will shoot a 40cm target face (Bowman and Cubs score outer 10-ring; Cadets and Junior score inner 10-ring). For Recurve archers: Bowman and Cubs will shoot a 60cm target face; Cadets and Juniors will shoot a 40cm target face.

WHERE: The 2016 Texas Cup will be held at Texas Archery Academy. Texas Archery Academy is located at 600B Accent Drive, Plano TX 75075. The Academy is located in the same parking lot as the PGA Superstore.

SHOOTING TIMES: JOAD line -Saturday at 1 p.m.
All other divisions: (Choose two of the following) Friday 6 p.m., Saturday 8 a.m., Saturday 6 p.m., Sunday 9 a.m.

COST: \$40 for the double FITA I portion; \$35 for the JOAD single FITA

1. I UNDERSTAND DANGERS may be caused by my own actions, or inaction's, the actions or inaction's of others participating in the Activity, and the condition. I understand the nature of The National Archery Association of the US activities and acknowledge my experience and capabilities and believe I am qualified to participate in such Activity. I further acknowledge that I am aware that the activity will be conducted in facilities open to the public during the Activity. I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation of the Activity.

2. I FULLY UNDERSTAND that activities involve risks and dangers of SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH ("Risks"); These Risks in which the Activity takes place or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW;
c. There may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES incurred as a result of my participation in the Activity.
